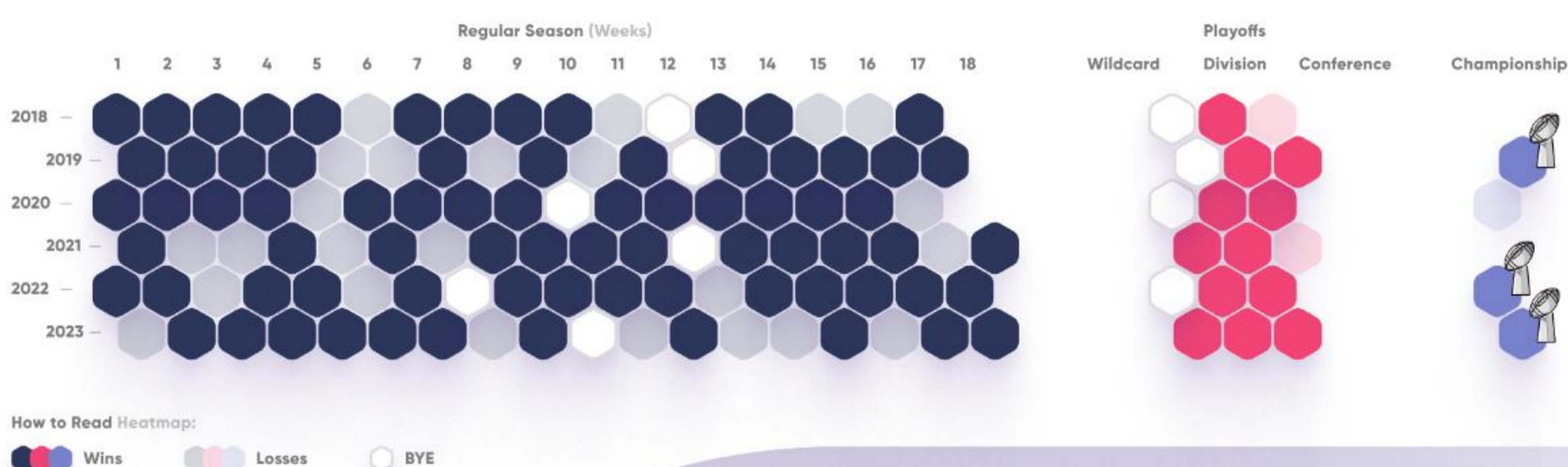

A MAHOMES-LED DYNASTY

When asked whether the Chiefs had become a dynasty, Mahomes replied: "It's the start of one."

Since becoming the starting quarterback in 2018, Patrick Mahomes and the Chiefs have made it to every conference championship while hosting **five** of the **six** games at Arrowhead stadium. He also made it to **four** of the **six** league championships in that time and won **three** of them.

CATCHING THE GREATS

Patrick Mahomes wins an unprecedented **83.3%** of his playoff games. Thanks to this winning percentage, he has already made his way to the leaderboard for most playoff wins ever by a single quarterback in **NFL history**.

Mahomes has already surpassed the highly esteemed Terry Bradshaw (14), John Elway (14), and Peyton Manning (14) in career playoff wins with only Joe Montana (16) standing between himself (15) and Tom Brady (35).

AN UNPRECEDENTED TRAJECTORY

Patrick Mahomes has won playoff games to the tune of 15 games through seven seasons, with only six of those seasons being a starter. That outpaces the great Tom Brady who, in his first six seasons as a starter, only won 12 playoff games.

Even if Mahomes doesn't win a single playoff game in the next four seasons, he would still remain on Brady's record-breaking trajectory.
